Are you interested in having a summer job? Do you know that the experience that is gained through summer work looks good on your resume for future employment? Would you like to register for a summer job near your home? If the answers to these questions motivate you to apply for work, here's what you need to do to get started. Registration begins with the Department of Employment Services on February 2 and ends on April 26, 2008.

Any DC youth ages 14-21 are eligible to register. Youth 13 years old must turn 14 years old by Monday, June 16, 2008 in order to be eligible. Individuals who turn 22 years old on or before June 16, 2008 will not be eligible to register.

5. School Record

#### Proof of Social Security Number (Choose One)

1. Social Security Card
2. Department of Human Services' Letter
3. Veteran's Medical Card
4. TANF Record
5. Tax Form 1040 or D-40

#### Proof of Citizenship (Choose One)

1. Alien Registration Card
2. Baptismal Record
3. Naturalization Certificate
4. Military Discharge DD-214
5. Foreign Passport Stamped "Eligible to Work"

#### Proof of Residency (Choose One)

1. Government Agency Letter or Printout
2. If homeless, a letter from the shelter
3. Rental Lease
4. Current School Report Card
5. Current School Record, i.e. IEP or V Form
